Council Briefs

December 12, 2006

Council approved a request from the Pibroch Agricultural Society to flood their skating rink.

Council received a request from a business operating in the County to have the business parking lot graded and snowplowed free of charge. Council moved to adhere to existing policy, and to provide the business with grader services on request, at the regular fee rate for the service.

Council received a letter from Dapp Power asking for consideration for work on some roads used by the Plant. Council directed Administration to review the request with Dapp Power, and to develop a proposed strategy for funding the work requested.

Council reviewed a report relating to animal pound services, and authorized signature of an agreement for pound services with the Westlock Veterinary Center .

Council also reviewed and approved a Traffic Safety Plan as prepared and submitted by Special Constable Ergang.

Council authorized signature of an agreement with Kyetech Canada Inc. to provide dispatch services for Westlock County Protective Services.

The County's development processes were discussed by Council in relation to a current development proposal, and a request to remove the requirement for engineered design plans to be reviewed by an engineer hired by the County. After discussion, Council re-confirmed the County's existing procedures, and the requirement for review of plans by the County's engineers.
