

Westlock County Council Briefs - April 24, 2007

Council asked Administration to look into grants available to use in recognizing the 100th Anniversary of the Hamlet of Vimy

Council asked that public works staff assess work requested at the Westlock Golf Course, and proceed, within the amount allocated in the Budget, with placement of asphalt millings in the parking lot, and gravel and maintenance on the road into the course

Council approved a recommendation to sell the County's motorscrapers to Ritchie Bros. for \$298,500.00 plus GST in the amount of \$17,900.00.

Council reviewed information provided in response to a request relating to election of the Reeve. Council agreed that the request should be discussed with the public, for feedback, and agreed to put the matter on the agenda for the annual meeting.

Council provided a letter of support, in principle, to the Canadian Tractor Museum for their application for Special Federal Grant Funding to build a shop.

Council accepted a recommendation of Administration to enter into a three year contract for attendant services at the County's Long Island Lake Park
