

Westlock County Council Briefs – August 14, 2007

Westlock County Council has instructed the Municipal Planning Commission to bring forward recommendations as it relates to the possibility of restricting the establishment of manufactured homes in the County's Hamlets.

Council authorized an Advance Poll for the 2007 Municipal and School Election, the date will be at the discretion of Administration.

Administration was instructed to investigate the possibility of establishing painted crosswalks to both entrances leading into the Vimy Lions Park.

Previously the County accepted an offer to purchase the Fawcett Hotel, the original buyer chose not to finalize the offer, however, the Council has now accepted a new offer to purchase the property, at a higher amount than the one original one.

Council accepted the recommendation of Administration to proceed with the development of a portion of the County's Industrial Park.

County Council confirms its current policy of maintaining approaches from the driving surface to the property line, at the discretion of the Public Works Department.

Administration provided an interim report to Council relating to the financial position of each municipal department. It was reported that based on the available information all municipal departments will be able to remain within the approved budgetary parameters to the end of the fiscal year. The Public Work Department may have to curtail its current operations to remain within the operational budget. Further information will be presented to Council at the next Meeting in order to provide additional clarification to Council.
