

**Westlock County Council Briefs – November 27, 2007**

Westlock County received confirmation from Alberta Health and Wellness that the County will receive the same level of funding for 2008 as they received the previous year for the operation of the ambulance service. In 2007, the County received \$160,500.00 as an operational grant for the County's portion of the regional ambulance service.

The County also received correspondence from the Westlock Golf Club requesting assistance from the County for the upcoming year.

Administration was directed to establish a five-year surface water management plan for all Hamlets.

Council established the reserve bid for all the properties scheduled to be sold during the upcoming Property Tax Recovery Auction Sale. The Auction will take place at the County Administration Building at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday December 6, 2007

Council has authorized Administration to apply for funding under the Alberta Municipal Infrastructure Program for a total of \$70,000.00 to address the County's project of rejuvenating a second water well for the Hamlet of Vimy.
