CHECKLIST

- Y / N Are you over 18 years of age?
- Y / N Has the seller provided you with the manufacturer's instructions on safe use of fireworks?
- Y / N Has written permission been obtained from the land owner at the discharge site?
- Y / N Has written permission been obtained from the land owner /occupant of neighboring lands on which debris might reasonably fall?
- Y / N If leaving Westlock County, has the Fire Department in the jurisdiction visiting been contacted if bylaw is in effect?
- Y / N Has the Westlock County Fire Protective Services been contacted at 780-349-3346 and provided with copies of the landowners/neighbors consent forms?
- Y / N Has the discharge site been cleared of dry grass and/or combustible material and entire discharge area thoroughly wet down?
- Y / N Is there a portable fire extinguisher, having a rating of not less than 2A in the immediate discharge area?

If you have answered no to any of the aforementioned questions, you will be in contravention of the Alberta Fire Code 2014.

Fireworks are to be discharged on private property only. No firework may be discharged from public lands (i.e. road allowance, crown property, beach, park).

A record of each sale must be kept on the premises where the sale occurs for a period of not less than two years following the date of the sale. This form must be made available to Westlock County immediately, upon inspection.
